“Just as soon as I get off the bus.” she answered.

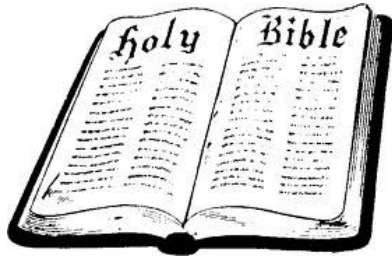

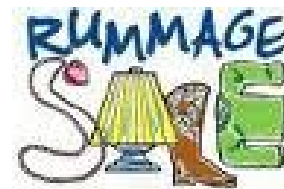

And, as has become a summer tradition, we also took groups to the Creation Festival and on a Summer Mission Trip. These trips were done in conjunction with the youth group of the Franklin Park Baptist Church. The weather was hot for creation---and so was the music. Group favorites included performances by Toby Mac, Skillet, Family Force Five and Hawk Nelson. We missed speaker Justin Lookado, but Bob Lenz's had a great message as always. We took the traditional trip up to the lookout point (even if the shortcut was a little steep). The group worked incredibly hard and did a great job. Thanks to all the youth who came and worked so hard, thanks to all those who supported the BYF and their fund raising efforts to raise money to fund the trip.
